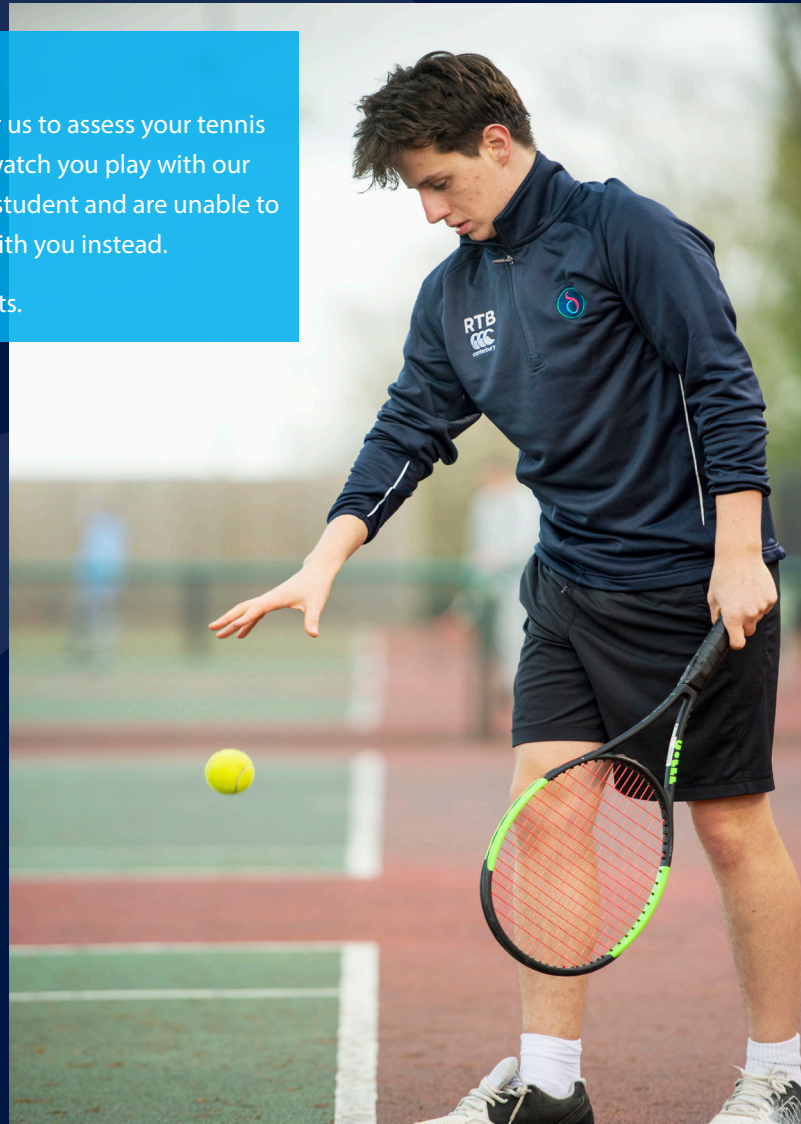
## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

LTA rating of at least 4.2 or above (or equivalent). In addition, and for us to assess your tennis ability, you will be required to attend an assessment where we will watch you play with our coaches at the North Oxford Tennis Club. If you are an international student and are unable to attend an interview in person, we will arrange a video assessment with you instead.

You will also need to meet our standard academic entry requirements.

## WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAMME?

- ③ 3.5 hours of d'Overbroeck's Tennis Academy group coaching sessions
- ③ 5 hours of North Oxford Tennis Club squad (ability appropriate) coaching sessions
- ③ 2 hours of one-to-one Tennis coaching sessions
- ③ Player assessment and reports
- ③ School competitions and fees when you are representing d'Overbroeck's
- ③ Access to indoor tennis courts for additional practice
- ③ Strength and conditioning programmes



For students on the Tennis Academy programme, all of the above will be included in our standard school fees. Please note there will be additional costs for gym membership (£48 per month), additional one-to-one coaching, sports massage and injury rehabilitation services and entry fees to club competitions.

## ABOUT NORTH OXFORD TENNIS CLUB

The club has around 500 members and offers many benefits to our Tennis Academy programme students, including:

- 9 floodlit macadam hard courts for all year-round tennis
- 10 grass courts maintained by full-time groundsmen
- Fantastic clubhouse with function room, Wi-Fi and changing rooms with showers
- Host of the British Tour Singles Competition (Pre-Wimbledon qualifier) each year
- Host of the Oxfordshire Junior County Championships
- Host of the Junior and Senior County cup championships
- National Tier representation in LTA Team Tennis event
- Multiple teams in Oxford league tennis
- 30 juniors train and compete for Oxfordshire in county squads and competitions
- 10 juniors in the regional training programme
- All coaches are LTA licensed with up-to-date safeguarding, first aid and DBS checks
- The club runs many internal events including box leagues, charity events, social events, team training and club nights
